### *What's new this year?*

There is no national contest this year, but don't let that stop you from entering. We'll still be awarding prizes at each of our three stations. We look forward to reading your entries!

### *Do I need to bind my story?*

No. We will accept your story whether it is bound, stapled, or simply paper-clipped. You may want to consider ease and cost of mailing when finishing your story. Also, keep in mind we scan all winning stories, so having the stories paper clipped or with a single staple works best and we prefer pages that are no larger than 8 ½ x 11 inches.
